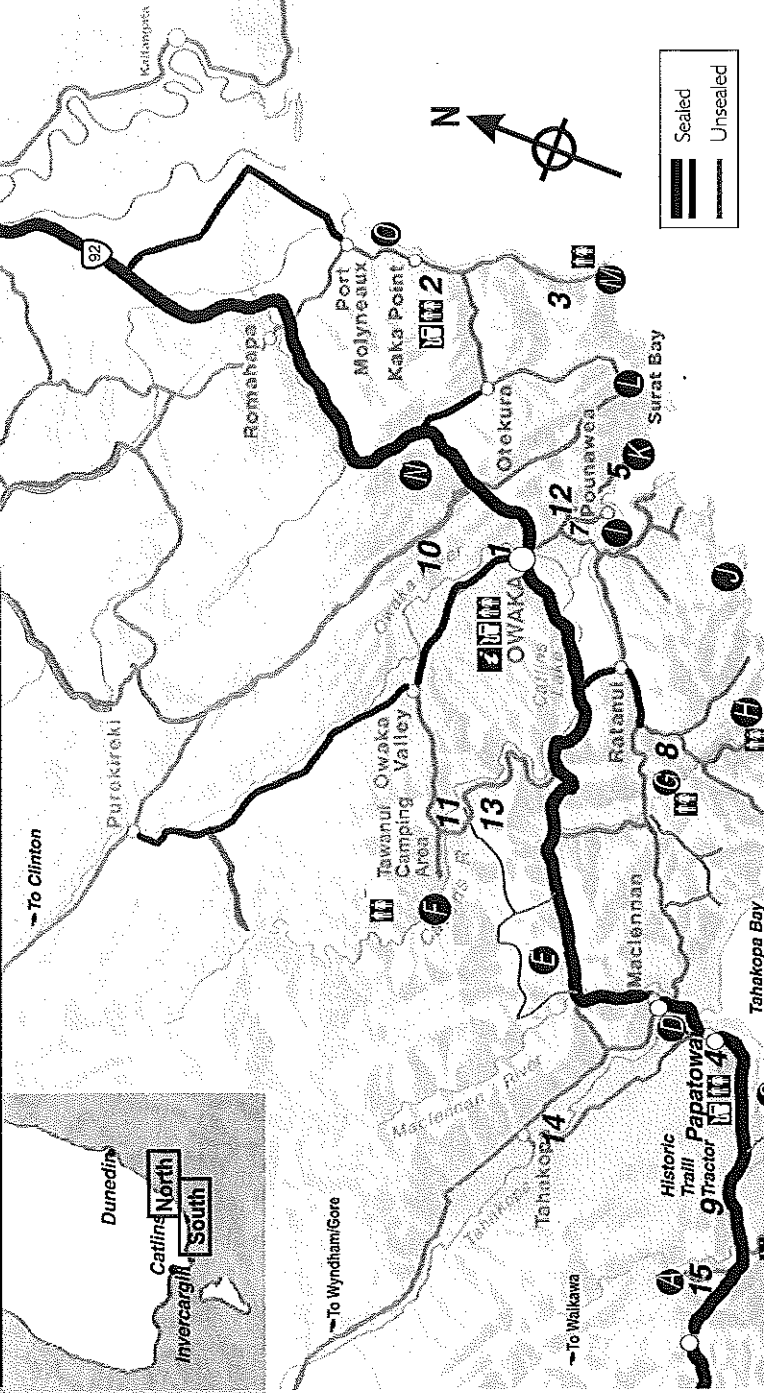

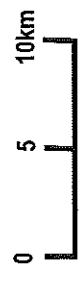

Attractions

- 1 McLean Falls - 20 minute walk
- 2 Cathedral Caves - 20 minute bush and beach walk to spectacular caves accessible only at low tide
- 3 Lake Wilkie - 10 minute walk showing succession of forest development from lake edge to mature forest
- 4 Papatowai - Camping ground, shop, forest and beach walks
- 5 Matai Falls - 10 minute forest walk to waterfalls
- 6 Catlins River Walk - 5 hour beech forest walk between the camping areas at Tawanui and The Wisp. Trout fishing.
- 7 Puraikaunui Falls - 10 minute forest walk from picnic area to waterfalls
- 8 Puraikaunui Bay - Attractive beach, camp site and picnicking
- 9 Pounaewa - Camping grounds, bush and estuary walks
- 10 Jack's Blowhole - 30 minute track to deep blow hole on cliffs 200 metres from the sea. Like nearby Jack's Island is named after Chief Tuhawaiaki (Bloody Jack). Closed Sept/Oct
- 11 Surat Bay - A long sandy beach named after the sailing vessel Surat, wrecked in 1874. Sea lions
- 12 Cannibal Bay - Named by geologist Dr James Hector after human bones were discovered in the dunes. Sea lions
- 13 Nugget Point - Lighthouse built in 1869. Fur Seals, breeding area for Gannets, Sooty shearwaters, Shags and Yellow Eyed Penguins
- 14 Tunnel Hill - Short track to tunnel excavated by hand between 1891-92 for Baiclutha - Owaka Railway
- 15 Kaka Point - Accommodation, services, forest & beach walk, dump station, fishing, boating, diving, shop & bar
